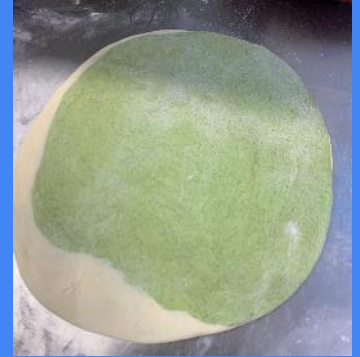

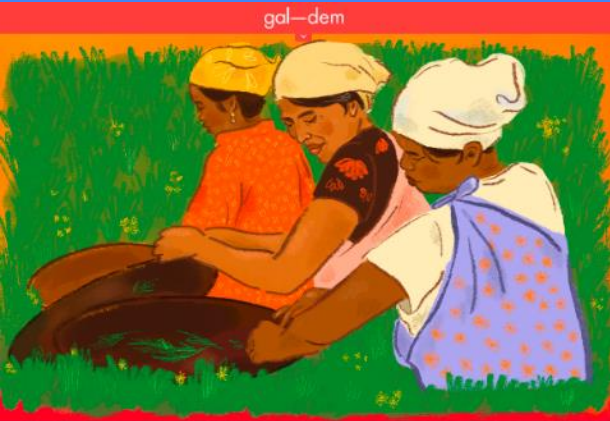

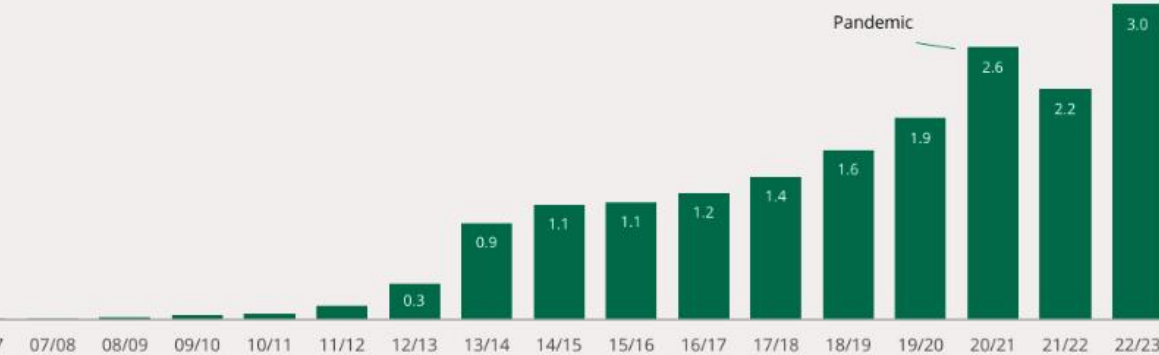




Insecurity During the Pandemic

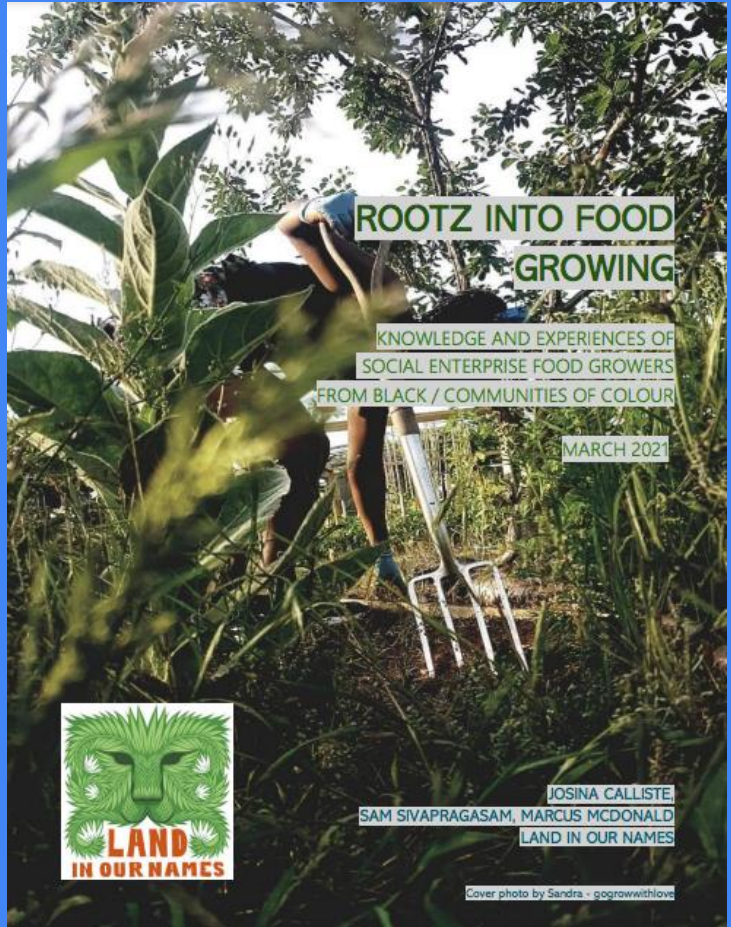
