A cash first approach to food insecurity is about people accessing income instead of charitable food aid as a response to poverty. At this moment of extreme crisis IFAN is encouraging food banks to distribute vouchers instead of or alongside food parcels or cash grants to help resist the further institutionalisation of the food parcel distribution model and enable as much choice and dignity in the here and now. But it would be preferable if this type of support could be accessed via advice agencies and ultimately if local authorities could distribute crisis payments in cash in an easily accessible way.
